MEMBERSHIP VOWS OF FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH:

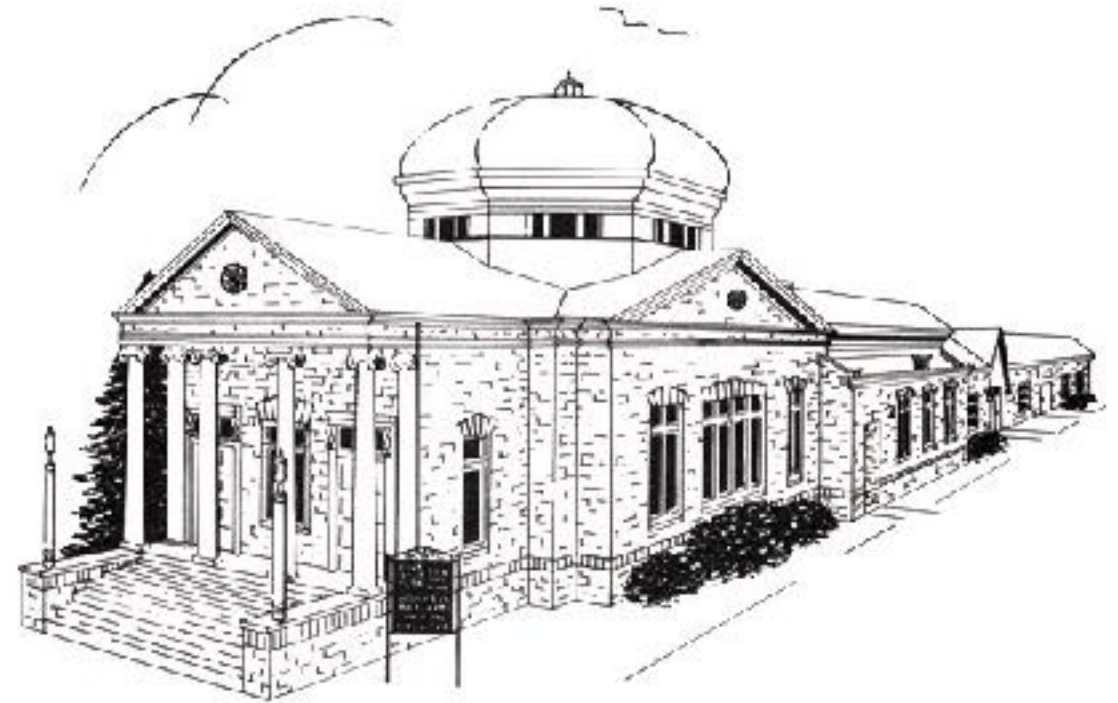
1. Do you acknowledge yourselves to be sinners in the sight of God, justly deserving His displeasure, and without hope save in His sovereign mercy?
